With the establishment of the Brisbane Diamantina Health Partners, there is an opportunity to draw together all the cancer researchers in Brisbane to advance collaborative efforts in cancer research.

In order to begin the process, a meeting will be held in the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre on 18 – 19th December 2014 before the Christmas break.

The meeting on 18th December will comprise plenary lectures on recent technological advances in the diagnosis and treatment of malignant disease from 2 – 4pm followed by workshops in these areas running from 4:15 – 6:15pm. This will be followed by a “Welcome Reception”.
